

PACT OCT 09

CANNABIS CULTIVATION

Early in October 2008 officers executed search warrants one being at the Water Culture Hydroponics based at Unit 38 Enterprise Centre Walton le Dale officers recovered a quantity of cannabis seeds and equipment. The search of the owner's home address in Lostock Hall revealed a hydroponic set up in the loft and upstairs bedroom. He was charged with producing cannabis and supplying cannabis and incitement to produce cannabis. He pleaded guilty at court. He was sentenced to 6 months imprisonment

Officers from Southern Divisions Financial Investigation Unit attended a confiscation hearing at Preston Crown Court. It was found that he had benefited from his criminality in the sum of £39,867. His only asset is his home address with equity of £22,855. He was ordered to pay £22,855 confiscation within 6 months. If he fails to pay his default sentence will be 13 months imprisonment. If he spends time in prison for non payment he will still have to pay the agreed amount when he comes back out plus any accrued interest..
