



CRIMES - HELP WANTED

Burglary other than in a dwelling – Thornbush, Hoghton Lane between 2230 hours on 230209 and 0900 240209 – shed broken into nothing stolen lock prised from door.

Criminal Damage – Swann Inn, Church Terrace, Higher Walton between 0100 070209 and 0105 070209 – offender threw object at front window of pub.

Burglary other than in a dwelling – Roach Bridge Paper Mill, Samlesbury between 1730 030209 and 0700 050209 – offenders have forced door and stolen large amount of electric wiring.

Burglary other than a dwelling – Badgers Way – entered insecure property and stole mountain bike between 2200 and 2215 on 190209.

Burglary other than a dwelling – Thornbush, Hoghton Lane between 2230 hours on 230209 and 0900 240209 – shed broken into nothing stolen lock prised from door.

Criminal Damage – Birch Crescent – between 2235 200209 and 0900 210209 offenders attempted to gain entry into van.

Robbery – Higher Walton Road – 2130 hrs and 2139 hrs 100309 – aggrieved threatened for mobile telephone no property obtained – offender described two males slim/medium build one wearing a red coat and red scarf and one wearing a blue jacket and blue scarf.

ASB Activity

During the month PC 852 carried out joint patrols:- Young Peoples Services, SRBC Park Rangers and Special Constable targeting areas raised at the last PACT meeting including, Walton Park (Leigh Brow), Holland House Farm , Coupe Green , Walton Le Dale Recreation Ground. Whilst in company with YPS over 50 young persons were engaged with and given information in relation to services available for them.

Councillor Jim MARSH raised a recent incident of Anti Social Behaviour at Coupe Green and the following night patrolled the area with Mick Moss SRBC Park Ranger and PCSO. Whilst checking Coupe Green a mobile phone was heard to go off and on further investigation a telephone , cigarette lighter and empty pack of lager were found in the far corner of the field. To date no one has claimed the phone.

The same night a group of youths were spoken to on Higher Walton Play Area, on request these youths tidied up the area collecting cans papers etc and putting them in the bins.

All park areas were visited at least once with the ranger.

On Friday 27 February PC 852 Edwards spoke to a group of youths on Millwood way drinking from cans of alcohol. Cans thrown into nearby bushes. Issued Youth Referrals and Restorative Justice carried out whereby youths climbed into bushes and retrieved their cans and other rubbish which was then disposed of in the correct manner.

Shortly after this a local off licence was visited and an offence of selling alcohol and cigarettes to an under age youth was investigated. This is subject to further investigation by the Police and SRBC Licensing Depts.
